







The soil with thorns represents people who hear and receive the word of God, but their faith/believing gets choked out of the person's life by the worries, riches, and pleasures of this world.





Other seed fell beside thorns which grew up and choked them.










The rocky soil represents people who receive the word of God with joy at first, but they don't believe deep in their hearts. When persecution or difficulties come, these people stop believing.


